



Background and Objectives

- Joint Agency Commercial Image Evaluation (JACIE) team formed in 2000
 - National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA), National National Geo-spatial Intelligence Agency (NGA), U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), and U.S. Geological Survey (USGS)
 - Annual workshops and documentation
 - Perform unbiased commercial system assessments and leverage each agencies' expertise
- Support Commercial Remote Sensing Space Policy
 - Improve communication with industry, both vendors and users
 - Increases confidence in commercial sources in the marketplace
 - Support research and showcase science applications
 - Provides data quality assessment model



Background and Objectives (cont.)

- Provides a model for government/industry cooperation
 - Good example for Global Earth Observing System of Systems (GEOSS)
 - Calibration and validation baseline is a must for science interoperability

 - Imagery market growing - Civil and Commercial imagery use expanding by Government and Industry
 - USDA joined in 2006 JACIE and National Oceanic & Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) supporting the workshop (3 years)

- CRS Requirements Database and Archive available on-line (USGS CIDR/UCDAM and NGA CCIL)






